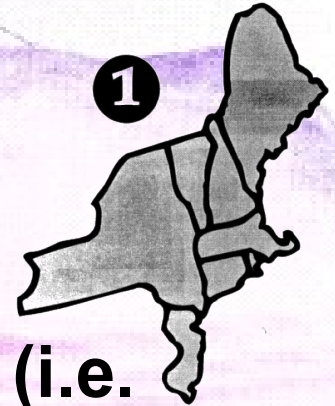
-worked with families affected by immigration to help get needed services and supplies
