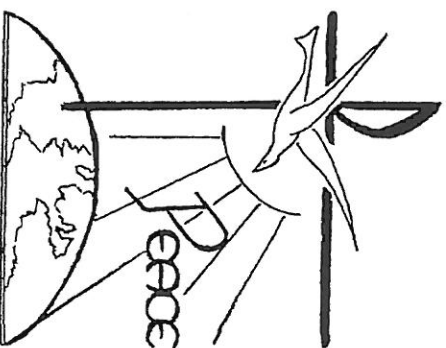

Directions

The Marian Shrine is located just 30 miles from the George Washington Bridge, 18 miles from the Tappan Zee Bridge, and 12 Miles from the end of the Garden State Parkway.

Take the Palisades Parkway Exit 14 (Willow Grove Road. / Letchworth Village). Exit Right and follow for 1.5 miles. Entrance is on the right.
(If You are coming from the north; take Exit 14 but turn left onto Willow Grove Road.)
